LOZANO SMITH ATTORNEY SUPPORTS ALMA MATER IN MOOT COURT PROGRAM

<u>Sloan Simmons</u>, Shareholder in Lozano Smith's Sacramento Office, was recently noted regarding his alumni volunteer efforts for the UC Davis School of Law Moot Court program.

In the September 6, 2011 posting on the <u>UC Davis School of Law News</u> site, the Moot Court program and volunteer participation was highlighted. Each fall, second year law students have the opportunity to participate in the Appellate Advocacy course, commonly referred to as Moot Court. This course includes a competition where students write appellate briefs and deliver arguments before volunteer judges.

As a volunteer judge to the intraschool competition, Simmons stated "I had a great experience in Moot Court.
